Havelchaussee 107. 14055 Berlin One of my favorite spots outside the city. It's an old boat with a restaurant on it. called "old love". They serve the best apple pie and you can go for long walks along the Havel, or go swimming in the summer.

Bröhan-Museum

Schloßstraße 1a. 14059 Berlin One of those weird state run museums :) that is specialized in Art Déco and Functionalism.

Abguss-Sammlung Antiker Plastik Schloßstraße 69b.

14059 Berlin Across the street from Bröhan-Museum vou find the collection of replicas of monuments and sculptures in Berlin. It looks like the backdrop of a potential Kanye West video.


